

Waimea Arts Council's (WAC)
All Hawaii Island Juried Art Competition

Theme: PORTAL

April 10 – 28, 2019 • Firehouse Gallery, Kamuela, Hawai'i

Entry Dates: April 4 – 6, 2019

This juried competition, open to all Big Island artists, pushes participant creativity beyond the norm.

The invited Juror: Sally French is eager to see PORTAL realized in a wide variety of ways.

So what does PORTAL mean? Check any dictionary or thesaurus and use those synonyms to spark your creativity. Then force your interpretation in unforeseen directions that, however unusual, still leave the theme PORTAL evident to the Juror and onlookers alike. Not an easy task, but WAC's challenge is met with cash prizes of \$500 for first, \$300 for second, \$200 for third, \$100 Honorable Mention prizes will be solely awarded at the Juror's discretion. Prizes to be awarded at the reception on Sat., April 13 at the 4:00 - 7:00 pm reception.

Prizes worth competing for!

The State Foundation for Culture and the Arts has been petitioned to view the juried results. Previous juried WAC shows have seen numerous artworks purchased by SFCA for the Hawaii State Museum collection and by the viewing public. Not a bad record for Hawaii Island's oldest art organization that's a volunteer run non-profit.

About the Judge: SALLY FRENCH is a multi-faceted artist from Kauai whose resume lists over 35 solo shows throughout Hawaii as well as having work in The Contemporary Museum, Honolulu Academy of Arts and HISAM collections. With 40+ mainland exhibitions her art has been shown from NYC and Chicago to New Orleans and Texas also in California where she was born. She's been a teaching artist and lecturer at Penland School in N.C.; The Art Institute of Chicago; and Trillium Press in S.F. to name just three of many. Among her awards is one from the prestigious National Endowment for the Arts.

Open to all Big Island Artists 18 and older.

ENTRANTS MUST COMPLY WITH EXHIBITION RULES:

- Competition **entry forms** are available online at: www.waimeaartscouncil.org
Please have all of them filled out and signed when entering. The bottom of the registration form will be your receipt when entering.
- You may enter a **maximum of three (3) pieces**.
Works must be original (no prints or reproductions will be accepted, with the exception of photographs). Works must not have been shown in any other juried show.
- **Size limitations:**
 - Two-dimensional works can be no larger than 9 sq. ft. Measurements made from outer edges of proper framing and be wired for hanging.
 - Three-dimensional works can be no larger than 9 cubic ft. (HxDxW). Gallery help must be able to move any piece without injuring themselves.
- EACH artwork must have tags attached to the hanging wire denoting: Title, Medium, Price, and Artist's Name in full with Contact Phone Number.

- **All works must be priced for sale.** Not For Sale (NFS) artworks will not be accepted. Sales commission split: 50% to the artists and 50% for the Waimea Arts Council.
- **Non-refundable Entry fees** will be collected for each piece on this sliding scale:
One piece - \$30; Two pieces - \$50; Three pieces - \$60.
Fees to be paid in cash or with a check made out to Waimea Arts Council.
Credit cards will only be accepted at the Firehouse Gallery.
- **Locations for Entering:** The Waimea Arts Council wants to make it convenient for island artists to enter this show. There will be three locations for **entries to be accepted from 10:00 am to 3:00 pm:**
 1. **Hilo* pickup** will be Thursday, April 4 at the former location of Central Supply, 31A Makaan Street
 2. **Kona* pickup** will be Friday, April 5 at Kona Frame Shop, 74-5484 Kaiwi Street, in the Old Industrial Park
 3. **Waimea drop-off** for walk-in entries will be on both Friday & Saturday, April 5 & 6 at the Firehouse Gallery (Hwy. 19 & 190), 67-1201 Mamalahoa Hwy., Kamuela, HI 96743

*NOTE: Drop-off entries made to Hilo or Kona must be protectively wrapped for transport. Artwork should have already completed forms with fees ready to be paid by check or cash. Propose organizing with other artists to enter work together.

- **Artwork not juried into the show** MUST be retrieved from Waimea on either Monday or Tuesday, April 8 or April 9, from 11:00 am to 3:00 pm. Artwork not picked up will be considered a donation to the organization.

- **Picking artwork at the end of the show**

All work (except those pieces sold) must be picked up at the Firehouse Gallery on either Monday or Tuesday, April 29 or April 30 between 11:00 and 3:00 pm. Pieces not picked up by the artists or representative will be considered a donation to the organization.

..... **No return service will be provided for any artwork**

The Waimea Arts Council will handle all work with the utmost of care; however artists will be responsible for liability of individual art and will hold the Waimea Arts Council and the County of Hawaii harmless for loss or damage. A signed waiver form is included on the entry form below.

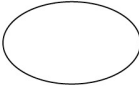

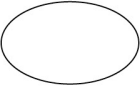

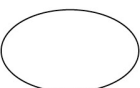
