Waimea Arts Council's All Hawaii Island Juried Art Competition Prospectus HUAKA'I*

July 1 - August 28, 2022 • Firehouse Gallery, Kamuela, Hawai'i Entry Dates: June 25 & 26, 2022

This juried competition, open to all Big Island artists, pushes participant creativity beyond the norm.

The invited Jurors: Stephen Freedman and Philippe F. Nault

* Huaka'i translates to journey, trip, voyage.

The competition asks Hawaii-Island artists to express this theme through their art. Not an easy task, but WAC's challenge is met with cash prizes totaling \$1,200 and will be solely awarded at the Juror's discretion.

The Hawaii State Foundation for Culture and the Arts (SFCA) has been invited to the show to acquire works for the State collection. Past juried shows have seen numerous artworks purchased by SFCA for the Hawaii State Museum collection and by the viewing public.

About the Judges: Stephen Freedman, a third-generation potter/sculptor, has been working out of a Big Island studio since 1991. Previously he'd been exhibiting pieces produced at his LA studio. Work by Stephen has been exhibited in galleries and museums throughout the United States and in Japan, China, and Australia. Numerous public and private collections contain pieces he's produced over the past five decades. Currently, his focus has been on architectural scale vessels using a combination of wheel and hand-building techniques. Many of the recent pieces are finished with multiple layers of Chinese and Japanese stoneware glazes. www.stephenfreedman.com

Philippe F. Nault came to Hawai'i in 1992 and is well-known for his abstract paintings. His work has been shaped by the primeval forces of nature and his exploration of Hawaiian indigenous ontology. They address a perception of the world in general, a *Landscape of the Self* as a core concept of his artistic career. Prior to arriving in Hawai'i Mr. Nault created a number of oversized artworks both abroad and in the US. Three of these were commissioned by the French State for public installation. He is also an interpreter of Hawaiian culture and a practitioner of *CHADO*, Japan's traditional tea ceremony. *www.philippenault.com*

Open to all Big Island Artists 18 and older.

ENTRANTS MUST COMPLY WITH EXHIBITION RULES:

- Competition entry forms are available online: www.waimeaartscouncil.org/category/call-for-art/
- You may enter a maximum of three (3) pieces.
- Works must be original (no prints or reproductions will be accepted, with the exception of photographs and digital art).
- Works must not have been shown in any other juried show.
- Artworks must have been created within the past 2 years.

Size limitations:

- Two-dimensional works can be no larger than 9 sq. ft. Measurement is made from outer edges of proper framing and should be wired for hanging.
- Three-dimensional works can be no larger than 9 cubic ft. (HxDxW). Gallery help must be able to move any piece without injuring themselves.

- All works must be priced and available for sale. Not For Sale (NFS) artworks will not be
 accepted. Sales commission split: 50% to the artists and 50% for the Waimea Arts Council. Artists
 are responsible for collecting the cost and arranging for shipping of sold art.
- Entry fees will be collected for each piece on this sliding scale:
 One piece \$30; Two pieces \$50; Three pieces \$60.
 Fees to be paid in cash or with a check made out to <u>Waimea Arts Council</u>.
 Credit cards will only be accepted at the Firehouse Gallery.
 Fees are non-refundable and are utilized for the cash prizes.
- How to enter: Download and complete the entry forms on the website and bring with artwork on Saturday or Sunday, June 25 or 26, 2022 from 11 am to 3 pm. Forms will be available when entering at the Waimea Arts Council's Firehouse Gallery, 67-1201 Mamalahoa Hwy., Kamuela, HI 96743. Notification of selections will be announced on June 27.

Artwork not accepted for the exhibition

Pieces not selected for exhibition must be picked up at the Firehouse Gallery on either Tuesday or Wednesday, June 28 or 29, 2022 between 11:00 and 3:00 pm. Pieces not picked up by the artists or representative will be considered a donation to the organization.

Picking artwork at the end of the show

All work (except those pieces sold) must be picked up at the Firehouse Gallery on Sunday, August 28 between 11 am and 3 pm. Pieces not picked up by the artists or representative will be considered a donation to the organization.

The goal of this exhibition is to showcase fine art works produced by artists on the Big Island of Hawai'i.

The Waimea Arts Council will handle all work with the utmost of care; however, artists will be responsible for liability of individual art and will hold the Waimea Arts Council and the County of Hawaii harmless for loss or damage. A signed wavier form is included on the entry form below.
