Student Requirements

- 1. Open to students in the Hāmākua and North and South Kohala Districts only.
- 2. Grades 6-12 including home schooled students

Art Requirements

- 1. Maximum two pieces of art in any medium PER STUDENT.
- 2. Work must have been completed during this school year
- **3.** Art can be any medium, two-dimensional (drawings, paintings, collages, weavings, photographs, digital, etc.) or three-dimensional (ceramics, sculptures, jewelry, etc.)

Labeling Requirements

Submissions need to be submitted online through email:

- a. One jpeg, per 2-D piece, 200 dpi or larger
- b. Two jpegs, per 3-D pieces, 200 dpi or larger
- c. jpeg files need to be labeled with submission number from the submission form.

Please title files as: Number of submission, Artist Name (sample: 1_JoeySmith.jpg)and Title of piece.
